

Qualities Worthy of Recognition for "Woman of the Year" Award - 2019

To help you when choosing a woman to nominate, below are some examples of qualities the nominated woman should possess:

• Confidence:

She is confident and believes in herself and her abilities. She knows she is capable of succeeding.

• Integrity:
